Our Proposal in Your Behalf


We Propose the Formation of

Westbourne Prophetic Bible Institute Church Association

for the purpose of building a combined Church and Bible Institute in a central location in Calgary at a cost of approximately Fifty Thousand Dollars (see cut on page 1).

The building is to contain:

- (1) An adjustable Auditorium capable of seating 1200 to 1500 people for church and lecture purposes.
- (2) A Bible Institute or School Assembly Hall with movable partitions to accommodate 300 students.
- (3) Residence Accommodation for 50 students.

Of What Value will it be?

"Not FAILURE but LOW AIM is crime."

The Westbourne Prophetic Bible Institute Church Association propose to serve its supporters and people generally in the following way:

(1) A Fundamental Baptist Church will thus be established where the pure doctrines of the Word of God will be regularly upheld and the Sacred Ordinances of the Christian Church will be properly administered.

It will be a real Church of the Open Bible.

- (2) A Bible institute will be made available to our young people of the Western Provinces, and any others, who desire a careful training in Bible Knowledge, Personal Evangelism, Homiletics, Public Speaking, Bible Teaching and other kindred subjects, without the fear of atheistic or modernistic theories that undermine and destroy faith.
- (3) A regular Sunday afternoon or evening broadcast of Fundamental and Prophetic Doctrines, which would enable our friends and supportes in the remote parts of the provinces to have the benefits of such meetings and such teaching brought to their firesides, and which would give them the privilege of hearing some of the leading speakers on religious subjects as they visit the Institute from time to time.

Possibly a mid-week Bible Lesson Course might also be broadcast if it was so desired.

- (4) The staff of the Institute would be available for part of the year, at least, to hold evangelistic services or to give lecture courses, here and there, throughout the West. This would strengthen the local churches. Furthermore, as time went on, our graduates would be ready to carry the teaching of the Institute into the various districts.
- (5) The Institute might also publish and distribute suitable religious literature, lectures, and probably a monthly magazine, so that our people could keep in touch with the latest and best in religious thought.
- (6) For those who are unable to attend the Bible Institute, Bible Correspondence Courses might be arranged.

Without doubt the Westbourne Prophetic Bible Institute Church Association would become one of the greatest features in the religious realm of the Western Provinces. It is an investment worth while, not only here, but hereafter.

As John Knox worked and prayed for Scotland, let us work and pray for Western Canada.
