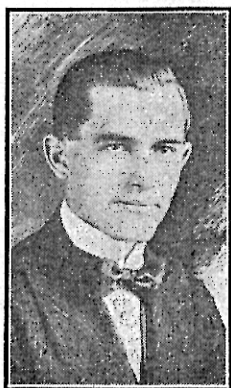

# WESTBOURNE CHURCH'S NEW PASTOR PREACHES

Rev. E. G. Hansell Welcomed  
By Big Congregations  
On Sunday

Rev. E. G. Hansell new pastor of Westbourne Baptist church, preached his opening services last Sunday before a crowded congregation. Taking for his morning subject "The Four Greatest Facts in the Universe, or Four Things a Minister Should Believe," he gave a very clear cut testimony and left his congregation in no doubt as to his own attitude to the fundamentals of Christian belief. He first made it clear that he accepted the Bible as the inspired word of God and the only infallible rule of faith and conduct, and then proceeded to his four points.

### Virgin Birth of Christ

He maintained that the belief in the virgin birth of the Lord was the great cornerstone of religion, for to deny it contradicted the plain word of God and made Christ a sinner with the rest of mankind, and therefore unable to die for a lost humanity. People object to the virgin birth and say it is not scientific, yet Dr. Luke, a physician and scientist himself who knew Mary, the mother of Jesus, accepted the fact and also wrote of it in his gospel. While not belittling the life and example of the Lord, he pointed out that Christ came to die for mankind and not to live for them.

### The Atonement

He lived a sinless life that He might be able to atone for mankind and take their place as a substitute. He went to hell for man, and so has reconciled to God all who accept Him as their Lord and Saviour.

### His Resurrection

He not only died and went to hell, but on the third day He rose again. God thus showing His approval on His sacrifice. He rose from the dead that He might go to the right hand of the Father, there to receive His kingdom and to return again.

### His Return

Some day He would reign on this earth and occupy the throne of His Father David. Mr. Hansell pointed out, however, that he was not himself looking for the coming of Christ to reign on this earth but that he was looking for that day when with the voice of the archangel and the trumpet of God, the dead would be raised from their graves and we, which are alive, would be caught up together with them to meet the Lord in the air and so be forever with the Lord—that this blessed hope of the Lord's appearing was his daily expectation.

## WHALE CERTAINLY SWALLOWED JONAH

Rev. Hansell at Westbourne  
Baptist Declares His  
Faith in This

"I have less difficulty in believing that the whale swallowed Jonah than that man sprung from some lower unnamed form of life," declared Rev. Ernest G. Hansell at Westbourne Baptist church last night.

"During the recent past," he said, "there have been doubts expressed by some as to the authenticity of the book of Jonah, or rather as to its literal interpretation. This means that they are asking if the book of Jonah is true.

"When the size of a whale's throat is declared to be so small that it can swallow only small fish, can it be true as the Bible states, that Jonah existed in the whale's stomach for three days and three nights? Is it true that men of intelligence can nowadays believe a story like that?"

"Well," said Rev. Hansell, "let me tell you this. If the book of Jonah is not true, how can I say that any part of the Bible is true. Is someone to tell me that certain parts of the Bible are true and others not? I say that if the book of Jonah is not true then Christianity is a fake!"

Rev. Hansell said that modernists maintained that God did not mean exactly what He said in the Bible. "But then," he said, "what in the name of common sense did he mean, for when God speaks he says exactly what he means and in such a manner that we can understand Him. And if He does not then He is not the kind of a God that I want."

I may not understand how Jonah could spend three days and nights in the belly of a whale, but if God has put it in His sacred word then it is not ours to question why—ous is to believe."

Rev. Hansell said that in the course of his travels he often met critics who cavilled at all that was in the Bible. But the fault with them lay chiefly in the fact that they did not take their Bible in hand and try honestly to prove the truth of its statements, but instead attacks them.

"For what harm is there in believing that the whale swallowed Jonah?" said Rev. Hansell. "I would far rather believe what is the word of God than some of the truck that the modernists give us."

It has been claimed that the tale of Jonah and the whale is merely a piece of Jewish imagery, adorning a story with a moral meaning that disobedience will be punished. In the story Jonah sets out to preach in another town although told by God to go to Nineveh. A storm arises and he is cast off the ship to be swallowed by the whale and after three days finds himself on the shore near Nineveh.

This, declared Rev. Hansell, is a wrong interpretation of the story which, as the Jews took it, meant that when the Messiah came He would be three days dead and then resurrected. It was the final proof to them that Jesus was the Messiah.

"The book of Jonah was not a piece of Jewish imagery," said the speaker. "God says, 'as one, so the other' and if the book of Jonah is not true then the resurrection of Jesus Christ is not true either."

Rev. Hansell made reference to the statement of St. Paul in his epistles to the Corinthians, that Jesus lived, died and rose again. "According to the Scriptures." By this St. Paul referred to the Book of Jonah and the 16th Psalm.

"Paul said: 'If Christ did not rise again, then is our preaching vain and our faith vain,'" declared Rev. Hansell, and yet an eminent Bible student in the United States—a man who is famous all over the continent—states in a newspaper interview that there is every hope of recovering the body of Jesus Christ from the lost tomb, as it may have been embalmed. "I'll tell you where you will find the body of Jesus Christ. You will find it in heaven seated at the right hand side of God.

"The time has come," said Rev. Hansell, "when Christian men and women must fight for their faith, declare that Jesus is a very God and that every word in that old Bible which reveals Him is true from first to last."

### JONAH AND THE WHALE

Editor Albertan:

Such sermons as that reported by you today under the head of "Whale Certainly Swallowed Jonah" would tend to alienate me from the Christian gospel if I were without personal spiritual experience. The preacher who says, "If the Book of Jonah is not true, then Christianity is a fake," seems to me to have an insufficient message for an evangelical pulpit. Does his creed emanate from dead authorities, and know nothing of the living Christ? No wonder people are running from dead theology in search of newer fakes. I am not worried about the big fish which God prepared to swallow Jonah, for I have enjoyed communion with a living Saviour for nearly 45 years, having been brought into the liberty of the sons of God in a Y.M.C.A. Bible class on November 21, 1880. When preachers are so foolish as to say "Christianity is on trial," whenever their interpretations are assailed I wish you journalists would repel the canard.

## WESTBOURNE WON BUCKLEY SHIELD

Defeated Other Calgary Sunday Schools in Scripture Memorizing

Westbourne Baptist church won the senior, intermediate and junior shield presented by J. C. Buckley, M.L.A. of Gleichen, for Scripture memorizing in Calgary Sunday schools, winning over Hillhurst Baptist and First Baptist church. Mr. Buckley presented the shields Thursday evening at Westbourne church. Last year only one shield was presented for the three divisions, but this year, in order to increase the interest in the competition three shields were given.

J. C. Hunter was chairman of the meeting. Each department gave an exhibition, after which the shield were presented. Messrs. E. G. Hansell and N. Hutchinson sang a duet. Brief speeches were made by William Aberhart; Mr. Hampton, of Vancouver and Sunday School Superintendent Ford, Northfield and Scrimgeour.

The competition was divided into two parts: (a) Average number of verses memorized by the school as a whole in each department; (b) average number of verses memorized at home—both contests taking place the same night. Each school had two teams of five each, in each division. The shield has to be won by the same school three times in succession before it can be retained permanently.

## Westbourne Baptists Will Enlarge Church

They had raised from all sources during the year the sum of \$5,500, and the trustees had reported that the church was free of any liabilities.

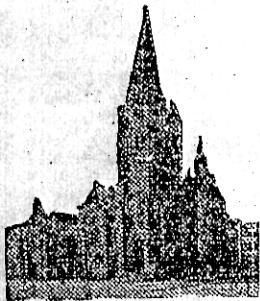

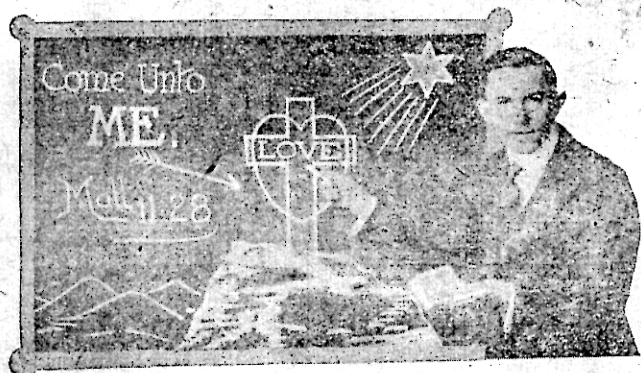
