The Social Credit Party expects its candidates and all members to stand loyally and steadfastly for the following principles:

1. The Safe-guarding of Democracy ^{TRUE}

(a) We are against any disallowance of the Acts of the Provincial Legislature, provided these Acts do not interfere with the rights of other provinces, nor with the external affairs of the Dominion.

(b) We favor and do strongly urge the immediate reconstruction of the Federal Constitution by calling a conference of Provincial representatives for that purpose.

"The Will of the People must prevail."

2. The Great Need of Monetary Reform.

(a) We are opposed to any private corporate monopoly of money or credit.

(b) We believe that no real prosperity can be enjoyed by our people until the issuance and control of all money and credit is taken over by the government and distributed to the provinces on a fair and equitable basis.

(c) We shall urge the definite policy of increasing the standard of living of every Canadian citizen in keeping with our natural resources. "Until the people demand it, there can be no change."

(d) We insist upon the limitation of interest rates and a more drastic legislation on debt adjustment. "Without purchasing power, distribution is impossible."

3. The Federal Responsibility for Social Services.

(a) We maintain that the Federal government must assume its fair share of financial responsibility in regard to,-

unemployment relief, mental hospitals, pensions - old age, mothers and widows, crime, education and public health.

(b) We would favor the provincial adminis-

tration of the foregoing. "0"

(c) We would demand the restriction of all immigration that would aggravate our economic problems. "The free interprovincial migration places the responsibility upon the Dominion."

4. The Unification and Solidification of Canada's Far-flung Areas.

(a) We should press for the immediate construction of national trunk highways from east to west; the reduction of freight charges; the introduction of greater subventions, and the encouragement of Canadian-wide interchange of goods.

(b) We would urge a broader scheme of home building and home ^{improvement} repairing in all the provinces. "United we stand; divided we fall."

THE SOCIAL CREDIT PLATFORM

The Social Credit Party expects its candidates and all members to stand loyally and steadfastly for the following principles:

1. The Safeguarding of Democracy.

(a) We are against any disallowance of the Acts of the Provincial Legislature provided these Acts do not interfere with the rights of other provinces nor with the external affairs of the Dominion.

(b) We favour and do strongly urge the construction of a Federal constitution acceptable to the nine provinces to be initiated by calling a conference of Provincial representatives at an early date for that purpose and not to be the revision of the B.N.A. Act.

2. The Great Need of Monetary Reform.

(a) We are opposed to any private corporate monopoly of money or credit.

(b) We believe that no real prosperity can be enjoyed by our people until the control and issuance of all money and credit is taken over by the government and distributed to the provinces on a fair equitable basis.

(c) We shall urge the definite policy of raising the standard of living of every Canadian citizen in keeping with the development of our natural resources.

(d) We insist upon the reduction of interest rates and more drastic legislation on debt adjustment. "Without purchasing power distribution is impossible."

3. The Federal Responsibility for Social Services.

(a) We maintain that the Federal Government must assume full financial responsibility in regard to crime, unemployment relief, mental hospitalization, old age pensions, and rehabilitation of return soldiers. We also hold it should assume its fair share of financial responsibility for public health, education, and mothers' allowances.

(b) We claim that administration of these services should be under Provincial jurisdiction.

(e) We advocate an aggressive policy for the training and occupational establishment of our young people.
