John H. Blackmore was born March 27, 1890 at Sublett, Idaho, son of William Blackmore and Mary Horn, and was brought to his father's homestead west of Cardston in 1892. In November of 1892 he slipped on a wet doorstep and seriously injured his right leg.

He entered Cardston Public School when 10 years old, riding in on a pony the 2½ miles from the farm and out again each evening. Thus he was able to get schooling only in the warm months of the spring and in the two warmer months of the fall.

In November 1901, he entered The Galt Hospital at Lethbridge where he remained for 16 months. After that he caught up in his grades to enable him to enter the University of Alberta at 19, the Calgary Normal School at 23.

He then taught for 21 years and was elected to Parliament in October, 1935.
