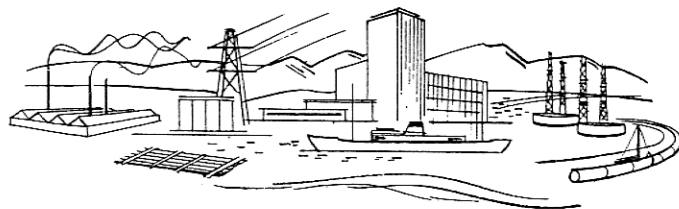

Mr. Low is one of the "originals" in the Social Credit movement in Alberta, elected to the Legislature in 1935, in 1940 and in 1944. He was appointed to the cabinet as Provincial Treasurer in January, 1937, and served in that capacity until 1944. He also served as Minister of Education in 1943 and 1944.

In 1944, Mr. Low was selected as Leader of the Social Credit movement in Canada at a National Convention in Toronto. He was elected to the House of Commons in 1945 to represent the constituency of Peace River.

He has continued to fight the battle for humanity and to abolish forever the two great scourges of humanity—unemployment and war.

In the past four years, Mr. Low has visited all parts of the constituency regularly to report his activities to the people and to receive further instructions from his electors. He believes in true democracy and has demonstrated his determination and ability to fight for this great cause and to establish in Canada the basis for lasting peace and security.

A successful teacher, farmer, business man and administrator, Mr. Low has consented to have his name come before the people once more in this present election. His record stands clean and unblemished. He makes few promises, but what he makes he keeps.
