Meny of us well remember the Austrian paper-hanger .. little mustache .. who became the strutting Hitler of infamous memory . . And puffy , bemedalled Mussolini, who threw his fighter planes against helpless spearmen of Ethiopis . . mowed down like corn. Yet these died like dogs. Muss. strung up by heels in pblic sque loday we hear sword rattling of Kruschev..viturerations of a Castro..bravedo of Nasser of Egypt..Rantings of Nkrumah of Ghana. bitter distribes of Mao Tse Tung of China. etc ... And some big nolitical talkers in our own land! LITTLE MAN'S BIG DAY! Getting world ready for some bigger men .. Two in particular .. Rev. 13:15-8...11,15-17. MR BIG..in nolitical realm. and MR BIG in ecclestical realm. WATCH! (3). And in these stirring, turbulent, stormy days..we live YOU. Me (.YOU, unsaved man or woman. in deadly peril. (b). Appeared on scene suddenly. thunder on brow. tempest in voice. Disappeared just as suddenly, swept to heaven in whirlwing. escorted by chariot of fire. In between is the story of this prophet of fire. and his mighty ministry. And he lived in one offhistory's great crisis times. Heed.

II. Take time look first at character of this men God used.

Only one reword..of one terrific sentence..123 words..to Jehorsm (king).(II Chron. 21:12-15) Elijah's devout immetuosity and temmestuousness did not accord with retient rengenship!
